



## Trader’s information pack

### How to book a pitch

- Read the terms and conditions for traders on the next pages
- Complete the application form and risk assessment form (at the end of this document)
- Pay a £20 deposit (cheque to “Maindee Festival Association” or BACS Account No: 29441323 and Sort Code: 56-00-59)
- Send application form + risk assessment + £20 deposit cheque or BACS evidence to:  
**Festival Trading, Maindee Library, 79 Chepstow Road, Newport NP19 8BY**
- If you want more than one stall, please complete an application form and send a £20 deposit for each stall.
- When we get your application, we will contact you to confirm the booking and ask for the balance of the pitch cost or, if we cannot book your pitch for any reason, we will return your deposit.
- **Payment** (+ £50 litter bond for food traders) for stalls must be paid two weeks before the event to confirm your booking.

### What will you be charged?

Pitch costs are based on the type of organisation you are (charity, small information gazebo, commercial food trader etc) and the size of your pitch (the width in metres). We use the table below to work out what you have to pay us. For example, a small non-profit organisation selling non-food goods on a 2m wide table is charged £20. Commercial food traders are typically charged £125 + a £50 returnable litter bond. Electric supply is £40 for demand up to £3kw.

Type	Description of stall	Cost
<b>A</b>	Small local non-profit making organisation, information only <b>or</b> items made by trader (not “bought in” goods ) <b>or</b> trading small items off a table or rug	£10 a metre
<b>B</b>	General goods, or mix of handmade and bought in (not food or drink)	£15 a metre
<b>C</b>	Large non-profit or revenue funded organisation (not food or drink)	£20 a metre
<b>D</b>	Small local food / drink trader	£20 a metre + £50 litter bond
<b>E</b>	Commercial event food / drink trader	£125 flat fee + £50 litter bond

## Traders terms and conditions

**Pitch location:** We want you to have a good trading day and try to make sure that you have an excellent location for the type of goods you are selling. On arrival you will be shown to your pitch. By prior arrangement only, large traders can contact us to visit the site in advance. If space is tight, we give preference to traders who book early.

**Litter.** No trade waste to be left on site. Food traders must pay an additional £50 **litter bond** which will be returned at the end of the trading period if a) no plastic or foam and only bio-degradable disposable items are used b) the area to 5 metres in front of your pitch is routinely cleared of litter during the event and c) no trade waste is left on the pitch site after the event.

**Traders must only sell goods specified in their application.** Stalls are priced on the basis of the products that the trader states they are going to sell.

**Traders must have finished their set up and be ready to trade by 11.30am** Traders can enter the site **from 9.00am**.

**Sound systems in stalls** are not permitted

**Bottled Gas.** All gas equipment in catering units must have current safety certification. Safety precautions regarding storage of bottled gas must be followed.

**Electrical Supply, Generators and Electrical items.** All electrical kit you bring onto on site must be safe. Silenced diesel generators (not petrol) are allowed on site. We can supply electricity for a charge of £40. Contact us in advance about your power needs.

**Waste water must be put into containers and taken away or disposed of in drains** and not poured on the ground. The digging of sumps is prohibited. The Environmental Health Officer will check to see how traders dispose of waste water/liquid.

**Traders must comply with the Health, Safety and Hygiene requirements** of Newport City Council. Environmental Health and Trading Standards Officers typically come on site. All counterfeit / illegal goods may be seized by Trading Standards.

**Items not permitted on stalls:** Petrol generators, plastic or foam: disposable food containers, bottles, cups or cutlery, Helium, Black Henna, Glass (except small glass ornaments and glass jewellery etc), body piercing equipment, lasers, fireworks, knives.

**All vehicles are brought on site at their owners' risk, and must be suitably insured.** The Festival cannot accept any responsibility for any loss or damage that may occur during the festival or set up and take down period.

**All tea, coffee and drinking chocolate sold at the Festival must be Fairtrade.**

**Employers' Liability and Public Liability Insurance** must be on display in stalls at all times. Likewise traders are responsible for ensuring contractors delivering to, or working on their stall, are suitably insured.

**No rebates will be given** to traders as a result of adverse weather conditions, nor as a result of changes in performance programmes within the Festival. The Festival will not accept responsibility for the level of trading during the event.

**Traders are required to comply with the terms of the premises licence.** A copy of the Festival licence will be held at the Main Festival Office. If a trader is closed down and / or evicted from site for contravening the licence or any of these terms and conditions or environment health standards, they shall not be entitled to any rebate of fees.
