


#### Welcome to Autumn!

#### Award-winning children's author Oliver Sykes comes to Maindee.

Fans of Jacqueline Wilson, Phil Earle and Anthony McGowan will love Fishing for Rainbows, written and performed by Oliver Sykes. The show is in the library at 3pm in the afternoon on Saturday 12th October.

Inspired by Oliver's own experience of being raised in poverty by his single-parent dad of Romany heritage, Fishing for Rainbows follows 12-year-old Kezia, and her boisterous twin brothers, Duke and Danior, who are also growing up in a single parent family after the death of their mum.

While her brothers regularly fish with their dad, Kezia stays at home, cooking and cleaning, until one day, when she is called upon to prove what she can do with a fishing rod... What could possibly go wrong...?



#### Quiet Sunday mornings in the library

Over the next few issues we will publish a short profile of one of the regular library user groups written by one of its members.

David Haggar from Newport Quakers, who meet on Sundays from 10.30am to 11.30am, writes: "Our origins are Christian but we are open to those of all faiths or none. Meetings usually lasts for an hour. In Quaker worship there are no ministers or creeds. We first gather together in silence to quiet our minds – we don't have set hymns, prayers or sermons. In the stillness we open our hearts and lives to new insights and guidance. Sometimes we are moved to share what we discover with those present. We listen to what everyone has to say to find its meaning for us. Everyone is welcome to share their thoughts. After the worship we share tea, coffee, biscuits and conversation. #### 12pm - 7pm Saturday 28th September


There's a great day out to enjoy on Chepstow Road at the end of September when local and international graffiti and mural artists will be creating a series of amazing artworks as part of Full Colour Maindee – a new festival of street art. The participating artists (including Consumersmith, Farrah Fortnum, Molly Hawkins, Jade Peplar and Rhys Webber) have been recruited by Andy O'Rourke, who has just created this colourful splash on The Triangle stage. You can expect a festival vibe – live music at The Triangle and the MUGA – performance art, street food, bar, market stalls and street games.

When you arrive check in first at Maindee Carpark or on The Triangle for full programme information.



#### Full Colour Maindee Street Artists

If you asked someone to name a current British artist they are likely to say Banksy – a street artist. He is probably the best known of a growing number of UK street artists who paint, spray or stencil, often radical, art work directly on outdoor walls and other public surfaces – usually in the street. You will be able to enjoy the work of hugely talented group of these artists who will be working in the district centre.



Molly Hawkins' work is inspired by natural forms and movement. She has created large scale public artworks in Mexico, Colombia and throughout the UK and Europe (see www.mollymural.com) and will be leading a team to transform the outdoor ball court at the back of the Maindee Car Park into the biggest floor artwork in Wales. Andy O'Rourke, the Festival curator, studied Fine Art in Newport in the 1990s. Since then he seems to have never stopped either drawing, painting, sculpting, spraying or designing. Andy is fondly remembered by hundreds (maybe thousands) of former local school children for the consistently outstanding parade arts workshops he provided for the first twenty Maindee Festival parades. Now he creates equally stunning large-scale murals - often inspired by the natural world. Check out Jade Peplar – who uses scraps from magazine and social media pictures to collage new joyful, playful imagery of stuff. Rhys Webber will be pasting up a set of

popular street artist in the Bristol area. Her work, often painted on a dark background, features paint strokes applied repeatedly to the surface to create a powerful sense of collective movement and colour. #### Grants for Maindee District Centre Businesses


And Kate, who's written a variety from Welsh poems to shor stories! As well, through her writing she expresses the essence of living with autism.




#### District Centre - next steps

We all want Maindee District Centre to be safe, clean and attractive – but how do we achieve that?

Having good quality public spaces is definitely part of this. The Greening Maindee volunteer crew continue to improve and maintain many outdoor public garden areas. The Maindee Unlimited team behind "Full Colour Maindee" is also now working on a range of further improvements. The area at the back of the car park will soon be getting seating and an outdoor table tennis table. An RHS award-winning garden designer is working on the site at the corner of Wharf Road and Chepstow Road. The new garden should be there in 2025. The team is also in touch with Newport City Council, who have commissioned a new design for the Maindee Square planting area. That work is also due to start next year.

Great food shops, like Jim Oliver Butcher, ABC Supermarket and The Farmhouse Bakery make the area more attractive to daytime shoppers - and the newly opened Maindee Fresh Food is giving people even more choice. Cafés, restaurants and takeaways are also on the up. There is even talk on social media about Maindee being the new "food capital" of Newport.
