Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q. What kind of things can we apply for?

A. Our previous New Paths fund supported lots of creative projects within Maindee between 2015-2017, such as: community workshops involving singing, making and music, photography projects, theatre performances, and textile arts.

We are reopening the fund as, Refreshing Maindee, to make sure our neighbours and friends have the opportunity to do something. You could: paint your front door, decorate your shop window, arrange a workshop with a creative professional, put on music sessions (or something else creative), put up some hanging baskets... the possibilities are endless!

Q. How much can we apply for?

A. There is a total budget of £5,000 for this scheme, with a maximum amount of £500 per application. Some projects may only need £50 worth of materials, others may need more.

We really don't want the funding side of things to put you off applying. If you think the neighbourhood needs it and it will improve your environment, let us know and we'll see what we can do. Also, if you think your project is worth more than £500, get in touch. We want to support as many projects as possible.

Q. How long will it be until we hear if we've been successful or not?

A. The Refreshing Maindee Panel will meet regularly to review each application and see what they can do to best meet your desires and provide value for money in the neighbourhood. We'd like to think we will get back to you within 2 weeks. We may contact you sooner to clarify your ideas or arrange to meet you so you can show us exactly where you'd like this project to take place.

Q. If our application is not successful the first time, can we amend and re-submit it?

A. Yes! We will always give you the reasons as to why an application has failed. If you think you can amend your application to take those reasons into account and rectify any of the points raised, we will happily look at your application again.
