# Decade of change

In 2014 several local organisations began meeting to identify common issues in the Maindee area. The picture on the cover, of children at The Patch, was taken in June of that year, at one of the Maindeewide events held to clarify what concerned people. A new charity, Maindee Unlimited, emerged from all this planning work with an aim to "transform Maindee into a sustainable community with a strong local identity, strong local economy and a reputation as an attractive, safe, culturally vibrant and cohesive place to live, work and relax".

The Charity then moved from planning to doing. Re-opening the Library in 2015 was a good start. Then the Greening Maindee programme started to transform nealected areas into attractive and safe spaces for people and wildlife. The benefits of the ongoing work of the Greening volunteers is now appreciated throughout the community. Maindee has a growing reputation as a "circular economy" hub (see pages 7-10) and the newly published "Taste of Maindee" recipe book (see page 4) identifies and celebrates the rich cultural vibrancy

of the area. The Triangle, which had fallen into dereliction, was saved and the site transformed. Sadly, the Indulge Café on the Triangle has now closed (times are hard for many local traders) but the building will soon re-open as a new community space (see page 17). Many new events and activities now take place in Maindee (just read through the newsletter!) and this all helps to strengthen the positive identify of the place and help it become more attractive, cohesive and connected.






It's time to start getting ready for this year's Maindee Festival on **Saturday July 6th** in the lovely wooded grounds of Maindee Primary School.

# Housing Survey

Housing is a **big** problem. Rents are often sky high. Old houses can be expensive to heat and are often damp. Some houses are just not fit to live in. Last year community housing professionals from Cympas advised Maindee Unlimited on what, if anything, the Charity might do to improve the situation. The idea of setting up a Community Land Trust seems a good way to move things forward. That local Land Trust would probably partner up with a Housing Association to start providing homes.

Sometimes a child, for all sorts of reasons, cannot stay with their own family. A foster carer can then accept a child as part of their own family for a month, a year, several years or just one night. You can become a foster carer whether you own your home or rent it, whether you're married or single, whatever your ethnicity or sexual orientation. **Maggie** and **Sylvia (pictured here)** both live in Maindee and are both highly experienced foster carers. They have both kindly agreed to share some of their experiences.

It was an advert for foster carers in the Argus back in 1972 that first caught Sylvia's eye. **"I decided to apply as I felt it would be lovely to give a child a loving home the same as my own two boys had.** 

My first child was a three-year-old boy who stayed with me for thirteen years. Since then I have fostered many children over the 51 years that I have been an approved foster carer. I am now 77 and have no plans for retirement. I currently have a 2-year-old child who has been with me for six months and prior to that I had a newborn baby who was with me for ten months until she went to her forever family. Fostering can be challenging at times but it is so rewarding to be able to make a difference to the lives of those most vulnerable in our community. **If you have a spare room and some love to share please contact Newport Social Services for a chat about how you can join the team.**"

Our second local carer, Maggie, has been fostering for 12 years. She says it gives her a sense of purpose and that she enjoys seeing the young people she works with mature and blossom into young adults. **"Anyone from any background can apply"**, she says. "I do have my own adult children and grandchildren but also know foster carers who don't have birth children of their own. I have worked with children of many different ages as well as those from different communities and cultures. I have learnt a lot from them. I personally enjoy working with teenagers but I know other carers who prefer younger children. **The local authority provides a lot of support to their foster carers"**.


